The original Olympics began in the eleventh century as a small regional festival, dedicated to the god Zeus. The origins of the town itself are the Mycenaeans who worshipped the goddess Rhea, sister of Cronus and mother of Zeus. Zeus went on to becoming the top god and founder of the Olympic games. The first Olympic games were held in 776 BC and reached their height of popularity in 576 BC. The events included foot races, wrestling, discus, javelin, long-jump, horse and chariot racing, and a type of boxing called pancratium. The games were banned in 426 by the emperor Theodosius II because they were pagan, and the temples were destroyed. The Olympic Games resumed once again in 1896 in Athens.
