DISEMBARKATION SCHEDULE

- You are requested to vacate your stateroom by 8:00am. Please plan your morning carefully as you must meet with your color tag group at the correct time and location. If you have time before your group meets, we encourage you to wait in the comfort of the Princess Theater, located Forward on Promenade Deck 7 where entertainment will be broadcast throughout the morning. Do not meet in your disembarkation lounge prior to the meeting time listed.
- Once clearance has been granted by the authorities ashore, the gangway will be opened and your colored and numbered group will disembark from the assigned lounges as listed.
- Please be aware that U.S. Customs and Border Protection will not permit you to disembark until your color group is cleared.
- All colored and numbered groups will disembark from their assigned lounge only.
- When finally disembarking the ship, please produce your "Cruise Card" at the gangway as you disembark.
- Local authorities and agencies ashore reserve the right to change the order and details of disembarkation.
- Those passengers remaining onboard the Caribbean Princess' next voyage must be inspected by U.S. Customs and Border Protection. If you wish to go ashore early and not return onboard immediately, you may disembark up until 10:30am. Alternatively please meet in the Crown Grill, Restaurant, Deck 6 at 10:20am where you will be escorted ashore. Please bring your government issued ID and proof of citizenship along with your Cruise Card. You will be allowed to re-board once all passengers have been inspected and clearance has been provided from the officials.
-  Platinum/Elite Members Lounge - If you have traveled as Platinum or Elite for this voyage, we are delighted to extend to you exclusive access to the Club Fusion, Deck 7 Aft, during your disembarkation. Doors will open at 7:00am and this lounge will remain available until the end of disembarkation procedures. Please bring your cruise/key card for identification. All other guests are invited to use any other public area while awaiting their meeting time.

BAGGAGE

BAGGAGE TAG TIPS

Any passenger registered on a flight departing New York before 11:30am the day of the ship's arrival who has NOT received RED, GREEN or LIGHT BLUE baggage tags should contact the Passenger Services Desk on Fiesta Deck 6 by Noon on the last day of the cruise.

You will receive in your stateroom today colored baggage tags which indicate your disembarkation group in New York.

- Remove all old tags except your home address label.
- Viewing this example use clear handwriting.
- One baggage tag should be placed on each piece of baggage.
- Please remove the small perforated end of each tag to carry as a gangway pass.
- Many bags look similar. Please review all tags when claiming your bags.

For any changes or additional information please contact the Passenger Services Desk or the Tour Office Desk located on Fiesta Deck 6.

"WALK-OFF" DISEMBARKATION

Passengers capable of handling their own luggage across the gangway and into the terminal have the option for a "walk off" disembarkation. Those wishing to participate in this disembarkation option should not leave out any luggage for collection. Kindly note that passengers choosing the "walk off" disembarkation are responsible for carrying all their own luggage.



BAGGAGE COLLECTION

To enable us to have a speedy disembarkation in New York, we would request your help in placing the majority of your baggage outside your stateroom before dinner of the last evening. This is necessary to avoid disturbing you during the early morning hours with baggage collection and to keep emergency exits and alleys clear in the case of an emergency. The remainder of your baggage should be placed outside your stateroom at your convenience after dinner. Please carry all breakable and valuable items, including duty-free liquor, ashore yourself to ensure their safekeeping, as we cannot be responsible for the longshoremen's handling of them. In order to avoid the possibility of baggage being wrongly placed, please ensure your baggage is tagged with the correct baggage tags.

HAND BAGGAGE

It is recommended that you carry all valuables and fragile items ashore yourself.



Passengers wishing to put liquor in their baggage do so at their own risk.

- Passports/proof of citizenship, flight tickets and cruise card should not be packed.
- Medication should be kept in your hand-carry baggage.

U.S. CUSTOMS, BORDER PATROL

U.S. CUSTOMS DECLARATION

These have been delivered to your stateroom and must be completed one **per family**.

- US Custom Border Protection will collect the forms in the terminal building after you have collected your baggage.

A REMINDER FROM U.S. Customs and Border Protection

When filling in your customs declaration you must declare on the reverse side of the form if you have exceeded your customs limit. When declaring you must state the total items bought NOT the amount you have exceeded the limit by.

U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE RESTRICTIONS

It is a requirement of the U.S.D.A. that no fruit, foodstuffs or flowers and plants are taken ashore in New York. On the spot fines will be enforced.

A REMINDER LIST

- To settle your shipboard account at the Passenger Services Desk before 11:00pm on the last day prior to our arrival in New York (if you have not made use of "Express Checkout").
- To return any Library Books to the Library on Deck 5.
- To return playing cards and indoor games to the Library on Deck 5.
- To check "Lost-and-Found" at the Passenger Services Desk.
- Check that you have no personal belongings left in your stateroom.
- Clear your stateroom safe deposit box and leave the safe box door open.
- Any last minute photographs can be purchased from the Photo Gallery between 6:00am to 10:00am the morning of disembarkation.
- Please register your name at the Passenger Services Desk for wheelchair assistance if required during disembarkation.
- The ability to dial shoreside from your In-Stateroom phone will be disabled at 10:00pm the evening before arrival into New York. If you require to make an urgent telephone call ashore please contact the Passenger Services Desk to assist.

SOME ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

DISCRETIONARY HOTEL CHARGE

For your convenience, a discretionary Hotel and Dining charge in the amount of \$10.50 per day for each passenger (including children) has been automatically included on your shipboard account on a daily basis. For suites and mini-suites the discretionary Hotel charge is \$11.00 per passenger per day. Should you wish to provide cash directly to service staff, you may pick up special envelopes at the Passenger Services Desk. The Hotel and Dining charge and any cash provided up to the standard \$10.50 or \$11.00 for suites and mini-suites per day will be shared amongst those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including the wait staff, stateroom stewards and accommodations staff, buffet stewards, galley staff, laundry staff and others.

PRINCESS CRUISES TRANSFER COACHES

Passengers with prearranged transfers to either JFK, La Guardia or Newark Airports as well as Penn Station, Grand Central Station and Port Authority will be issued with a transportation voucher for their transfer. This voucher must be presented when boarding the transfer coach in New York. Should a voucher be misplaced or lost, please contact the Tour Office, Fiesta Deck 6. Any passengers still wishing to purchase transfers may do so from the Tour Office, on Fiesta Deck 6 until 10:00am on the last sea day. The cost of transfer is \$34 per person to the airports or \$29 per person to the rail stations.
