### NOTICES

**Discharge Of All Garbage Into The Sea Is Prohibited:** Except Provided Otherwise. The MARPOL Convention and domestic law generally prohibit the discharge of most forms of garbage from ships into the sea. Violation of these requirements may result in penalties. All garbage is to be retained onboard and placed in the bins provided.

**Food Advisory:** Consuming raw or undercooked meats, seafood, shellfish, eggs, milk, or poultry may increase your risk of food borne illness, specially if you have certain medical conditions.

**Health Advisory:** CDC has issued a travel alert (Level 2-Practice Enhanced Precautions) regarding Zika virus transmission for people traveling throughout the Caribbean, Central / South America, Mexico, Oceania / So. Pacific Islands, Southeast Asia and Cape Verde, Africa. CDC also identified two areas in Miami (Wynwood, and a section of South Miami Beach) where Zika is being spread by mosquitoes. Pregnant women should not travel to those areas. Zika virus is spread primarily through the bite of an infected mosquito, which bites in the day and night, and lives both indoors and outdoors. Other modes of spread, including sexual transmission, have been reported. As additional areas of concern may be identified by CDC in the future, guests are encouraged to check the CDC website for the latest information at <http://www.cdc.gov/zika/intheus/florida-update.html>. Only 20% of people infected with Zika virus show symptoms which most commonly include fever, headache, skin rash, joint pain and conjunctivitis (red eyes). The illness is usually mild with symptoms lasting from 2-7 days. Although serious complications and deaths are uncommon, recent increases in birth defects and neurological syndromes are being reported in areas where Zika virus outbreaks have occurred. The CDC travel health advisory particularly impacts women who are pregnant (in any trimester) and women who are trying to become pregnant. Travelers can protect themselves by preventing mosquito bites and taking precautions including using insect repellents, wearing clothing which covers exposed skin and adopting safe sex practices. Pregnant women in any trimester should consider postponing travel to areas where Zika virus transmission is ongoing. Pregnant women who must travel to one of these areas should talk to their doctor or other healthcare provider first and strictly follow steps to avoid mosquito bites during the trip. Women trying to become pregnant who are thinking about becoming pregnant should consult with their healthcare provider before traveling to these areas and strictly follow steps to prevent mosquito bites during the trip. Mosquito repellent is available in the ship's gift shop or medical facility.

**For the safety and well being of children:** children's swimming pool personal flotation devices are available free of charge at the pool deck areas. Personal flotation devices (PFDs) are for use onboard the Adventure of the Seas and cannot be taken off the ship.

**Body Camera:** For the safety and well-being of all persons onboard, some members of our Security Team will be wearing Body Cameras as part of their uniform.
