### WELCOME TO COLONIAL FALMOUTH, THE CARIBBEAN'S GEORGIAN-STYLE GEM.

Once a major port in the 18th and 19th centuries, this Jamaican town grew incredibly wealthy off of sugar production. Ships laden with sugar and rum would leave for Britain daily, just as others would arrive with slaves. It was an age of prosperity and sophistication, marked by the splendid Georgian-style "Great Houses" still perfectly intact today. On the other hand, it was an economy entirely dependent on the slave trade—an age of inhumanity overshadowed by great fortune. All that came to an end with the Emancipation in 1840, and today, it's as if time stands still in colonial Falmouth.

Many of the same quaint wooden houses still line the streets, with village carpenters handcrafting custom furniture in age-old tradition. A few of the old Georgian brick mansions and sugar plantations are now open to visitors, full of antiques and memorabilia to feed the imagination. And Falmouth's tropical setting is just as romantic. A 30-foot bamboo raft takes you down the Martha Brae River as you listen to the legends of an era gone by.
