

Disembarkation Program for New York

Debarcation, Saturday, June 11th, 2011 will be at Pier 88,
Manhattan Cruise Terminal - 711-12th Avenue, West 50th St. New York, NY 10019

Enjoy every minute of your vacation with Freestyle Cruising®. With Freestyle Cruising®, even disembarkation day will be a breeze. Simply place your suitcase outside your stateroom on the last night with your color-coded luggage tags attached and keep a small overnight bag with the essentials. We ask that you vacate your stateroom by 9:00am, but you've still got a few vacation hours to enjoy a leisurely breakfast or just relax in one of our public lounges until your luggage tag color is announced. Important Disembarkation Information will be played continuously on channel 27 on your Stateroom TV. (Note: Announcements can be heard in public areas and through channel 23.) Just a gentle reminder, the ship will not be cleared if guests are congregating at the gangway area(s). Also remember, we are returning to a US port from a Non-US port and all guests will need to proceed through the Customs Inspection upon leaving the vessel. So, please plan for additional time! Before leaving, please make sure you have all your personal belongings.

Settling your account

6:00am-9:00am, Crystal Atrium, Deck 7, Mid – An itemized statement of your on-board credit account will be delivered to your stateroom after 4:00am on Saturday morning. If you have made arrangements to settle your account with a credit card, your charges will be automatically billed to your credit card and it will not be necessary to go to the Desk. All cash accounts need to be settled onboard before disembarking. However, we encourage you to settle your bills ahead of time to avoid the congestion paying last minute at the Credit Desk.

What is the service charge?

A \$12 USD discretionary service charge has been automatically added per guest per day (for guests three years and older) to your shipboard account for all staterooms. This charge will be shared among those staff members, including the restaurant staff, stateroom stewards and other behind-the-scenes staff who have provided services to enhance your overall cruise experience. However, certain staff positions (e.g., beverage service, concierge, butler and youth counselors) do not benefit from this shared service charge because they provided service to only some guests, not all. If you have received excellent service from any of these staff members, we encourage you to acknowledge them with appropriate gratuities.

Filling out your U.S. Customs Form

All Heads of Households, regardless of nationality, must complete one U.S. Customs Declaration Form to include those family members traveling with you and residing at the same address, whether you purchased anything or not. This form will be delivered to your stateroom by your room steward or extra forms may be picked up at Guest Service Desk.

You Must Declare the Total Value of All Articles Acquired Abroad that you are bringing into the United States, including those items purchased on the ship. All tax-free items (i.e. artwork, unset precious gemstones, perfume, cosmetics, antiques and U.S. made products), must be listed on the back of the Customs declaration form. Undeclared merchandise is subject to seizure and/or penalty. If you have exceeded your Customs exemption, you must list all purchases on the back of the Customs form and the head of the household must present themselves with receipts to United States Customs and Border Protection officials in the terminal in New York.

Our US guests exemption includes:

- Purchases up to \$800 per person
- 1 carton of 200 cigarettes – must be 21 years or older. Excess U.S. Cigarettes marked with "U.S. tax-exempt for use outside U.S." or "made for export only" will be seized. Applicable internal revenue taxes and duties will be assessed on cigarettes overages and foreign manufactured tobacco products.
- 100 Cigars (No Cuban cigars allowed) – must be 21 years or older
- 2 liters of alcohol as long as 1 is a product of the Bahamas – must be 21 years or older. Applicable internal revenue taxes and duties will be assessed on alcohol overages.

For our UK guests:

- 200 cigarettes; or 100 cigarillos; or 50 cigars; or 250g of tobacco
- 4 liters of still table wine
- 1 liter of spirits or strong liqueurs over 22 per cent volume; or 2 liters of fortified wine, sparkling wine or other liqueurs such as port or sherry.
- £340 worth of all other goods including gifts and souvenirs.

For our Canadian guests:

- \$750 (Canadian) worth of merchandise
- 40 Oz. (1.14 liters) of liquor or 51 oz. (1.5 liters) of wine or 24x120z. (355 ml.) bottles or cans of beer or ale
- 200 cigarettes, 50 cigars, 200 grams of tobacco and 200 tobacco sticks

Prohibited Items: Fruits, nuts, plants, soil, flowers, drugs, narcotics, indecent materials, Cuban cigars, African ivory, snake skin, turtle shell products, guns or weapons.

Alcohol pick up

Any alcohol that was purchased ashore and collected at the gangway can be retrieved on Friday evening between 7:00pm-9:00pm in the Java & India Rooms, Deck 6, Fwd, Portside. For any Liquor/Alcohol purchased from our Galleria Gift Shops, please collect these from 6:00pm-10:00pm at the Galleria Shops, Deck 7, Aft on Friday evening.

Wheelchair Assistance

Guests requiring wheelchair assistance into the terminal are kindly asked to meet at least 15 minutes before their color is called in Fyzz Lounge, Deck 7, Fwd. Wheelchairs and attendants will be standing by. Please keep in mind that our wheelchair assistance is not meant for guests participating in the Easy Walk-Off program.

Luggage information

Place your luggage outside your stateroom no later than 1:00am Saturday morning. A reminder: all liquids, gels & aerosols must be placed in luggage to be checked in at the airport. Keep documents (passports, proof of ID, airline tickets, etc.) in carry on luggage. Please note: If you are carrying your entire luggage off the vessel, do not place any colored luggage tags on your bags.

Easy Walk-Off Disembarkation

We want to tell you about a cool way you can disembark the ship. It's called Easy Walk-Off Disembarkation. If you'd like to participate, the only catch is you must be able to carry all of your bags ashore on your own. (So, for our guests with special needs, wheelchairs, strollers or guests with walking difficulties, it's probably best that you don't participate in this program) Please keep your entire luggage in your stateroom, and carry it off with you off the vessel.

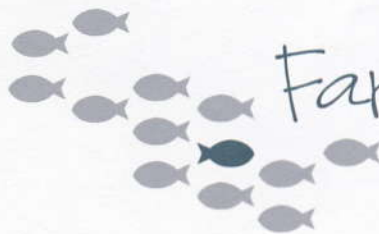
- Disembark at your leisure anytime as soon as the ship has been cleared.
- You don't have to worry about the color-coded tag disembarkation system which lets you avoid the crowd in the baggage claim hall, so there is no worry to pick-up a color luggage tag.

Just say when. Here's where you can choose to leave us.

Simply pick up the luggage tag that corresponds with the time you would like to leave or your deck, (please remember to remove the old tags, and place the new color tag that you have chosen on your luggage). It's that simple! Luggage tags are located in the Crystal Atrium, port side information rack next to the Shore Excursion Desk on Deck 7, Mid starting Thursday evening (Day at sea). If you are participating in NCL Transfers to the airport or day rooms, the luggage tags will be delivered to your stateroom. Times are estimated and may be called earlier or later depending on luggage availability or the guest flow inside the terminal while clearing Customs. Please listen for announcements. Please do not disembark until your color luggage tag has been called. Also, have in hand your Jewel Guest Keycard, Passport or proof of citizenship, and completed U.S. Customs Declaration Form as you disembark the vessel. We anticipate commencement of checked luggage with assigned color tags at approximately 8:50am with a final call for all guests to disembark the vessel at approximately 10:00am.
