## FROM THE NAVIGATOR

### NAVIGATION INFORMATION

Throughout the night we maintained a westerly heading towards Bonaire leaving the Venezuelan coast on our port side. During the morning we rounded Point Lacre, the southernmost tip of Bonaire, as we headed for our berth in the town of Kralendijk. We picked up our pilot 1 mile from the berth, who assisted in bringing Queen Mary 2 alongside.

In the evening, once everyone is back onboard we will slip our moorings, leave the berth and alter onto a north westerly heading for Fort Lauderdale across the Caribbean Sea.

### NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

The letters were said to have been printed on the first-class passengers' tickets, indicating that they had paid extra for cabins on the port side of the ship going out and the starboard side coming home as to avoid the heat and glare of the sun in the Indian Ocean.



## Welcome to Kralendijk, Bonaire

Kralendijk (pronounced Kra-len-dyke) is a city located on the island of Bonaire, in the Netherland Antilles. The main language spoken in the town is Papiamentu, but because of the town's position on the tourist map English is widely understood. Kralendijk means coral dyke in Dutch. The charming island capital is a tiny gem of Dutch colonial architecture with attractive orange and ochre-coloured houses, buildings and churches, many with their neat white trim and red roofs, lots of trees and

an occasional small herd of goats crossing the almost traffic-free streets. The capital is small and easy to walk around with a small grid of main streets that include the historic old district, fort, government buildings, churches, cafés, restaurants and bars, and most of the shops. Off the coast of Kralendijk lies the uninhabited island of Klein Bonaire, a diving and snorkelling paradise, which can be reached by water taxi. Bonaire is a snorkelling and diving paradise and the surrounding waters offer truly world class diving and deep sea fishing - it has been voted among the world's top three dive sites.

## Enrichment Programme Speakers

### Guest Lecturer - Astrophysicist Dr. Roberto Trotta

Roberto Trotta graduated from ETH Zurich and obtained his PhD in theoretical physics from Geneva University (Switzerland). Between 2005 and 2008 he was the Lockyer Fellow of the Royal Astronomical Society at the Astrophysics Department of Oxford University and a junior Fellow of St Anne's College, Oxford. Roberto has recently been appointed as a lecturer at Imperial College London.

His research in cosmology employs advanced statistical methods to compare theoretical predictions with observational data from ground-based telescopes and satellites, in order to study the characteristics of the Big Bang and to determine the properties of dark energy and dark matter in the Universe.

Roberto takes part in many public engagement with science activities, involving children, students and adults and he regularly gives talks about astronomy and cosmology to very diverse audiences. He is a very experienced lecturer and presenter, and his science communication activities have won several awards, including the BA Lord Kelvin award and the Michelson Prize at Case Western Reserve University. ### Guest Lecturer - Canyon Ranch Speaker Dr. Bridget Walsh

Dr. Walsh graduated from medical school at the Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine. She completed her training in Internal Medicine training at Keesler Air Force Base in Biloxi and went on to complete her Rheumatology training at the University of Arizona. She has remained on faculty at the University of Arizona, practicing at the university for several years before transferring to the VA in Tucson where she continued to do rheumatology, research and teach. Two years ago she and 3 other rheumatologists opened the largest rheumatology practice in Tucson, Catalina Pointe Arthritis and Clinical Research, Inc. Besides having a very active clinical practice, Dr. Walsh is the Director of Clinical Research where research is ongoing to develop new drugs to treat arthritis, fibromyalgia and osteoporosis.

### Guest Lecturer - Naturalist & Author Dr. Elaine Campbell

Dr. Elaine Campbell is retired from the faculty of MIT (Massachusetts Institute of Technology) where she taught in the Program for Writing and Humanistic Studies. As a young mother in Tortola, British Virgin Islands, she gained experience in West Indian culture, literature, and the practical aspects of living in the Caribbean. She became fascinated by the flora and fauna of Tortola and of the Anilles in general. She later applied these experiences to defining a topic for her doctoral research. She subsequently published in scholarly journals throughout the world, and is cited in Who's Who in the World, Who's Who in America, Who's Who in Education, among others. She is co-editor of "The Whistling Bird" an anthology of writing by Caribbean women, published and later reprinted in England, Jamaica, and the U.S. She, her husband, and young grandson now live in St. John, U.S. Virgin Islands as well as in Sudbury, Massachusetts.
