THE PORT OF SOUTHAMPTON



In 1911 Cunard Line purchased three ships, renamed the Albania, Ausonia and Ascania, to begin a new service between London, Southampton and Canada. The route was intended to take advantage of a treaty signed between the Canadian and French governments whereby goods shipped to Canada through a British port received a rebate. Cargo was loaded in Tilbury Docks, London, and passengers joined the ship in Southampton, which then proceeded to Quebec and Montreal. This new route was pioneered by the Albania, which arrived in Southampton for the first time on 2 May 1911, beginning a long relationship between Cunard and Southampton. Cunard's headquarters remain in Southampton - now in the modern surroundings of Carnival House. Southampton also remains home to many luxury cruise ships, as well as being a very important container port. The outstanding harbour means it is the principal port on the south coast, and one of the largest in the UK.

LUGGAGE DELIVERY

Your luggage will be delivered directly to your stateroom/suite. Please be aware that this process takes a considerable amount of time and we ask for your patience and understanding. It is not unusual for bags within the same party to be separated so please do not be alarmed if only some of your set of luggage arrives. Please report any luggage problems to the Purser's Desk.

SMOKING POLICY

To respect all guests on board QUEEN MARY 2 all public spaces are designated as non-smoking within the ship, with the exception of Churchill's Cigar Lounge. Outside, on the open decks, the starboard side of the aft end of the ship on deck 8, under the canopy and on deck 7 aft under the clock are designated as smoking areas. All restaurants are non-smoking, this includes outdoor dining alternatives. Smoking is not permitted in staterooms. Whilst smoking is allowed on stateroom balconies, we ask that guests are considerate and keep smoking in this area to a minimum. Churchill's is a lounge dedicated to cigar and pipe smokers all day. The extensive cigar selection is stored in the built-in humidor area. G32 port side (upper level only) is a smoking area from 6.00pm onwards.

GENERAL EMERGENCY STATIONS DRILL

This afternoon an emergency drill will be held prior to our departure. It is a requirement of law that after boarding the ship, all newly embarking guests must attend and be instructed in their General Emergency Stations. On this occasion we strongly encourage all in-transit guests to refresh themselves with the emergency procedures and attend this drill. On commencement of this exercise, broadcasts will be made and alarm bells sounded, calling you to your Assembly Stations as indicated on the notice behind your stateroom door. Please carry your lifejacket with you, do not wear it and for safety's sake do not allow the belt to trail on the deck. The correct method of wearing a lifejacket will be demonstrated to you at the end of this muster. During this exercise all on board services will cease. We apologise for any resulting delay in resuming the ship's services and thank you for your co-operation in these matters of our mutual safety.

Public HEALTH PRECAUTIONS

In order to keep QUEEN MARY 2 healthy we kindly ask that when entering a dining area that you use the hand sanitisers provided. These are situated in many locations around the Kings Court Buffet area. We also ask you to use the tongs and spoons provided within the buffets and that you replace them, once used, on the plates or containers provided. Should you experience any symptoms of vomiting or diarrhoea whilst on board, it is essential that you telephone the Medical Emergency Line immediately, by dialling 999/911. Thank you for your assistance in this important matter.


