## NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY CHEWING THE FAT

"God made the vittles, but the devil made the cook" was a popular saying used by seafaring men in the last century when salted beef was the staple diet aboard ship. ## US IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

On the morning of arrival at Brooklyn, US Customs and Border Protection will be inspecting ALL QUEEN MARY 2 guests (disembarking and guests who are continuing their voyage with us) regardless of nationality. The inspection will be carried out in the terminal building. Guests are kindly requested to carefully follow the disembarkation instructions that will be delivered to your stateroom.

#### **DISEMBARKING GUESTS:**

After you have finally disembarked QUEEN MARY 2, you will collect your luggage from the baggage hall and then proceed through this important lmmigration Inspection and clear Customs.

#### **GUESTS WHO ARE CONTINUING THEIR VOYAGE WITH US:**

All guests continuing their voyage with us are required to attend the Immigration and Customs Inspection. Please be advised that you will NOT be allowed to return to the ship until all guests have disembarked. However, if you are not intending to go ashore for the day, please proceed to the Terminal when the final announcement is made, which is expected at 10:30am. Once you have cleared the inspection, you may proceed to the Embarkation Hall where there is seating available. You will be advised once you are allowed to re-board QUEEN MARY 2. There is no need to check-in again.

## YOU WILL REQUIRE TO PRESENT THE FOLLOWING AT THE INSPECTION:

PASSPORT: All guests regardless of nationality are required to present a passport to the Immigration Officials. Please keep your passport open on the information photo page.

US CUSTOMS FORMS: All guests (or one per family with the same last name) are required to complete the Customs Declaration form prior to arrival in the USA.

IMMIGRATION FORMS: If you are a US citizen, a Green Card/ARC Card holder, a Canadian Citizen or if you are a passport holder of one of the nationalities listed under the Visa Waiver Programme and you are in possession of an ESTA no immigration forms are required. If the above does not apply to you then you must complete I-94 (White) form.

#### LIBRARY BOOKS

All guests who are disembarking in New York are kindly reminded that library books must be returned to the Library no later than 2.00pm today. Guests are reminded that books may not be taken off the ship under any circumstances.



#### HERITAGE CORNER

In total, over 250 ships have sailed under the Cunard flag since Samuel Cunard founded the company in 1840.


