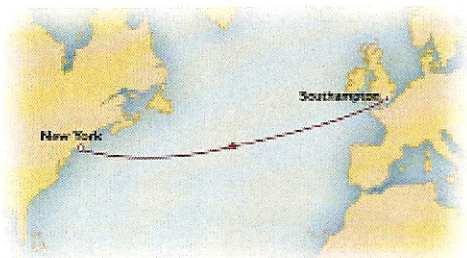

On the last of our 6 sea days across the North Atlantic Ocean, QUEEN MARY 2 shall steer a due westerly rhumb line course, as we make our approaches inland. We shall keep to the south of the Fundian Channel and the Nantucket Shoals, before passing 65nm South of Cape Cod.

We shall be picking up our pilot very early tomorrow morning, just before 0400.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

CHEWING THE FAT

"God made the vittles, but the devil made the cook" was a popular saying used by seafaring men in the last century when salted beef was the staple diet aboard ship. This tough cured beef, suitable only for long voyages when nothing else was as cheap or would keep as well, required prolonged chewing to make it edible. Men often chewed one chunk for hours, just as if it were chewing gum and referred to this practice as 'Chewing the fat' now a common phrase for extended conversations.

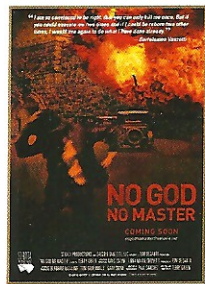
THE MERCHANT OF VENICE

US IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

On the morning of arrival at Brooklyn, US Customs and Border Protection will be inspecting ALL QUEEN MARY 2 guests (disembarking and guests who are continuing their voyage with us) regardless of nationality. The inspection will be carried out in the terminal building. Guests are kindly requested to carefully follow the disembarkation instructions that will be delivered to your stateroom.

DISSEMBARKING GUESTS:

After you have finally disembarked QUEEN MARY 2, you will collect your luggage from the baggage hall and then proceed through this important Immigration Inspection and clear Customs.

GUESTS WHO ARE CONTINUING THEIR VOYAGE WITH US:

All guests continuing their voyage with us are required to attend the Immigration and Customs Inspection. Please be advised that you will NOT be allowed to return to the ship until all guests have disembarked. However, if you are not intending to go ashore for the day, please proceed to the Terminal when the final announcement is made, which is expected at 10:30am. Once you have cleared the inspection, you may proceed to the Embarkation Hall where there is seating available. You will be advised once you are allowed to re-board QUEEN MARY 2. There is no need to check-in again.

YOU WILL REQUIRE TO PRESENT THE FOLLOWING AT THE INSPECTION:

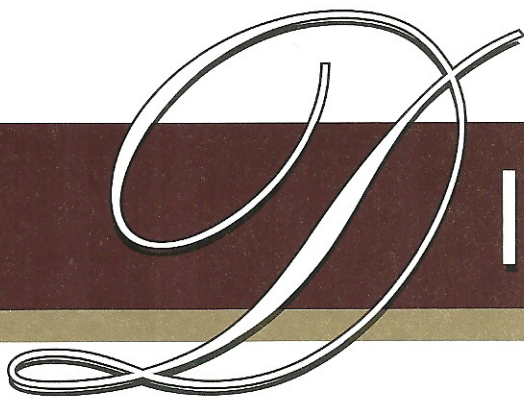
PASSPORT: All guests regardless of nationality are required to present a passport to the Immigration Officials. Please keep your passport open on the information photo page.
