## FROM THE NAVIGATOR

### ⊙ TIME CHANGE

Please be reminded that early this morning the ship's time was SET BACK ONE HOUR.

### NAVIGATION INFORMATION

During the early hours of this morning, Queen Mary 2 continued on her Rhumb track towards the Tail of the Grand Banks of Newfoundland. Our track this evening will take us over some of the deepest sections of the Atlantic itself with soundings in this area of more than 4500 meters or 2.5 miles. We will be passing approximately 50 nautical miles to the South of the Flemish Cap. Only 40 miles wide with depths of as little as 100 meters, this area of relatively shallow water feels the effect of the cold Labrador Current flowing from the North and the warmer North Atlantic Current from the South.

### NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

#### RADAR

Radar is the abbreviation of "Radio Direction And Range" and it's a device for detecting objects by sending out pulses of radio waves; if these strike anything they are reflected back and the time taken for these echoes to return is measured. As the speed of radio waves is known, this time can be automatically translated into the distance of the object. Direction is given by the direction in which the transmitting aerial points at the time. By the 1940's warships were using radar for shadowing an enemy and providing ranges for gunnery. After the war radar sets were installed in merchant ships as aids to navigation and for the prevention of collision.

## David Stephenson - Hotel Manager

David joined Queen Mary 2 in September 2004 and became part of the years of tradition proudly associated with the Cunard Company. David is however no stranger to life aboard passenger ships, a career he has followed for over 30 years. David was born in Darlington in the North East of England. On leaving school David did his Degree in Leeds before starting work in a famous London Hotel as a Trainee Manager. His move to things nautical happened in 1972 when he joined the P&O Steam Navigation Company as a Cadet Purser. In November 1972 he joined his first ship, the Oriana, in Southampton sailing for Australia. On leaving Oriana he joined the Arcadia in 1974 before going to Princess Cruises in 1975. With Princess, David worked on many ships, Sun Princess, Pacific Princess, Island Princess and finally Royal Princess when at the age of 34 he was promoted to Hotel Manager, the youngest Hotel Manager in the Company. In 1989 David left the sea for the first time to spend more time with his family taking a General Manager position with a large catering company in the UK. At this time David moved to Wetheral in the Eden Valley a small village outside Carlisle where he still lives today with his wife Doreen and son Luke. In 1998 David returned to sea again, this time with Royal Caribbean International as a Hotel Director. In his time ashore the 45,000 tons of the Royal Princess had been dramatically overtaken and he worked on the 74,000 ton Vision Class Ships Enchantment and Grandeur of the Seas. He also spent some time in Finland as part of the start up team that bought the 135,000 ton Voyager of the Seas over to Miami. He well remembers watching the Queen Elizabeth 2 visiting Miami on her 2000 World voyage, and realizing she was the smallest ship in port, so he is pleased that Cunard has once again re-established her position at the top of the Super Liner League. In 2001 following an offer from a friend David joined Newcastle Falcons as Operations Director and project managed the Catering installation of 5 kitchens and nine bars in the Falcons new 13 million pound stadium extension. In addition he set up all the Conference and Banqueting and Corporate Hospitality offer for the venue. It is rare that one can enjoy one's love for a particular sport and get paid for it at the same time. It was also quite a thrill to work alongside such sporting notables as Rob Andrew and Jonny Wilkinson. David left the Falcons returning to Princess, in early 2004 and did two short contracts on the Grand and Coral Princess before moving to Cunard in September. For David his love of ships is paramount and to work on the largest and most prestigious ship in the world is a real accolade. He hopes you enjoy the fine facilities of this floating legend.
