## VISITING THE BRIDGE

We receive many requests for visits to the Bridge. Unfortunately for both security and operational reasons we are unable to accommodate these requests. However while we do have viewing windows behind the Bridge, they only accommodate approximately 8 people, and therefore, we ask that if you find this number of people upon arrival that you come back at an alternative time. This facility will be available on most, but not all days, between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm. The viewing area can be accessed via 12 deck 'A' stairway on the port side through a door which will have a notice 'Open for Bridge Viewing'. If this sign is not displayed then please do not enter. Whilst in the Bridge viewing area we request you remain quiet. Food, drinks and smoking are strictly prohibited. **No videoing from viewing windows is allowed** and we ask that you do not disturb the Bridge Officers as the ability to view this area is currently on a trial basis.
