WELCOME TO NEW YORK, USA!

New York City (also known by the initials NYC), officially the City of New York, is the most populous city in the United States and the most densely populated major city in North America. Located in the State of New York, New York City has a population of over 8.4 million within an area of 321 square miles (approximately 830 km²). The city is a centre for international finance, fashion, entertainment and culture, and is widely considered to be one of the world's major global cities with an extraordinary collection of museums, galleries, performance venues, media outlets, international corporations and financial markets. It is also home to the headquarters of the United Nations. The New York Metropolitan Area has a population of about 22 million, which makes it one of the largest urban areas in the world. The city proper consists of five boroughs: The Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Queens, and Staten Island. Each of these boroughs, except for Staten Island, is home to at least a million people and would each be among the nation's largest cities if considered independently. Nicknamed "the Big Apple", the city attracts large numbers of immigrants, with over a third of its population foreign born. Moreover, it attracts people from all over the United States, who come for its culture, energy, cosmopolitanism, and economic opportunity. At present, the city has the lowest crime rate among the 25 largest American cities.

- In the 1660s New York City's "skyline" was dominated by a two-story-high windmill.
- When the Dutch still controlled the region, Wall Street was the city limit and there was actually a wall there.
- New York Yellow Cabs are yellow, because John Hertz, the company's founder, read a study that concluded yellow was the easiest colour for the eye to spot.
- The vaults 80 feet beneath the Federal Reserve Bank on Wall Street store more than 25% of the world's gold bullion.

SHIPBOARD INFORMATION

CHANGE TO CUNARD SMOKING POLICY

The safety, comfort and enjoyment of all our guests continues to be our primary concern at Cunard. With this in mind, and as a direct result of the feedback we have received from our guests, we have amended our policy with regard to smoking onboard all Cunard liners. For all voyages departing on or after 22 April 2010, smoking will no longer be permitted in the Casinos on board Cunard liners. Smoking is allowed in Churchill's Cigar Lounge, the port side upper area of the G32 nightclub and designated areas on the open deck, as well as in staterooms and on all private balconies. Smoking will not be permitted in any other inside area of the ship. Smoking of cigars and pipes is only permitted in Churchill's Cigar Lounge. Smoking is also permitted outside on deck 7 aft, under the clock and deck 8 aft under the canopy.

Please register your children after the drill (until 5.00pm) at the following locations: 1-5 year olds with the Nursery Nurses at the Zone deck 6, aft. 6-17 year olds with the Youth Staff at the Zone deck 6, aft.

At 4.00pm today, all guests who have embarked today in New York will be exercised in a general emergency drill. This exercise is a requirement of law and you must attend. On commencement of the exercise, broadcasts will be made and alarm bells will be sounded, calling you to your designated muster station as indicated on the notice behind your bathroom or stateroom door. Please carry your life jacket with you; do not wear it, and for safety's sake do not allow the ties to trail on the deck. The correct method of wearing a life jacket will be demonstrated to you at the end of this muster. **Please note that some guest services will be curtailed for the duration of the drill.**
