FROM THE NAVIGATOR

NAVIGATION INFORMATION

Having departed our anchorage yesterday evening, we have made our way across the chain of the Windward Islands and maintained a south easterly course overnight across the eastern extremes of the Caribbean Sea, and the early reaches of the Atlantic Ocean towards Bridgetown, Barbados. After boarding our pilot this morning QUEEN MARY 2 will pass the breakwaters into the port of Bridgetown and commence a large alteration of course to starboard before proceeding to the berth and commencing disembarkation. This evening after clearing the port breakwaters and disembarking our local pilot, QUEEN MARY 2 will set a northwesterly course back across the Caribbean passing between the islands of St Lucia and Martinique later tonight.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

THE KNOT

At sea we measure a ship's speed in "knots". This is one nautical mile per hour which is 1.15 miles per hour or 1.85 kilometres per hour. The term comes from the olden days of sail when a series of knots were tied in a line of rope attached to a chip or log and spaced out at a distance of 47 feet 3 inches. The log was trailed out behind the ship with the knotted rope being paid out over the stern. The number of these knots which ran out while a 28 second sand-glass emptied itself gave the speed of the ship in nautical miles per hour. Today however, with our numerous electronic devices, we have located on the ship's hull an instrument which measures the ship's speed by the rate of water flowing past it. It transmits the calculated result up to computers on the ship's Bridge. This device is called a "speed log".

WELCOME TO BRIDGETOWN, BARBADOS!

Barbados is a medium sized island that is 21 miles long and 14 miles wide, located in the far south eastern corner of the Caribbean. It is the most easterly of the Caribbean islands, situated about 100 miles east of the Windward Islands chain. The climate is semi tropical with an average temperature of 80 degrees Fahrenheit with only nominal seasonal variations. Barbados is also cooled by the constant trade winds blowing from the ENE across the Atlantic toward the Caribbean. The direction of these winds is remarkably constant which have made Barbados easily reached by sail boats from Europe (downwind) but very difficult to reach from the other Caribbean islands (always lying upwind). This helps to explain why Barbados alone was not subject to repeated conflict between the Caribbean colonial powers and, once colonised by England, remained English until her recent independence. The history of Barbados is fascinating. Many historical places and buildings are popular tourist attractions. The first important facet of her history is that Barbados has always been English since the first English settlement at Holetown in 1627. In fact, her name is actually derived from the Portuguese word, Los Barbudos, which appears in a document issued by King Ferdinand of Spain in 1511. The name means 'the bearded ones' which most believe to be a reference to the many bearded fig trees on the island.

SECURITY PRECAUTIONS WHILST ASHORE

In order to prevent unauthorised persons boarding the ship, you are required to carry your QUEEN MARY 2 "Identity Card" with you when going ashore. You will be asked to produce this at the gangway when you leave and return to the ship. Please be aware that we have established a secure area around the vessel and our security procedures require that you must be prepared to show your cruise card when entering this area, in addition to showing it to the security staff at the gangway when leaving or boarding the ship. We kindly ask you not to accept and bring on board any parcels or packages from strangers. Before boarding the ship, you may also be asked by our Security Staff to open parcels or handbags which you are carrying. We are sure that you will appreciate that this security is in the best interest of all concerned.

STORAGE OF LUGGAGE IN NEW YORK

Guests who wish to store luggage after disembarking the Queen Mary 2 in New York prior to their return voyage in the future may do so with Luggage Concierge in New York. Please register at the Purser's Office. The cost of this service is \$65.00 per bag for up to 30 days and an additional \$30.00 per bag for the next 30 days. This will be charged to your onboard account. Bags must be collected in the Terminal ashore from the baggage hall and dropped off with the Luggage Concierge Representative after exiting Customs. Please note that New York requires 48 hour notice, therefore the deadline for the above service expires at 6.00pm on Monday, the 10th January 2011.
