Today we continue our South South Easterly track towards the Islands of the West Indies and by the middle of the day we will be roughly on a parallel with Miami, Florida. The end of the day will see us still in deep water, approaching the Puerto Rico Trench where water depths reach up to 8000 metres or 26000 feet.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

ENSIGN

The country in which a ship is registered is indicated by a flag known as an ensign. Traditionally, this flag is flown from the gaff, which extends from the top of the foremast, just aft of the bridge, when at sea or the staff on the stern of a ship whilst alongside a quay. British vessels may fly one of three different ensigns, which consist of a union flag on one of three colored backgrounds. The red ensign (or red duster, as it is often known) is flown by British registered merchant ships. It was originally used to denote the senior squadron of the English fleet. The blue ensign is flown by British naval auxiliary vessels, such as those operated by the Royal Fleet Auxiliary and originally denoted the rear admiral's squadron of the English fleet. A blue ensign may also be flown by a merchant vessel if the commanding officer has attained the rank of commander or above in the royal naval reserves. The white ensign is flown by all ships of the British Navy. It originally denoted the vice admiral's squadron of the English fleet. When hoisting the ensign, a sailor must be very careful and ensure it is flown the right way up. An ensign flown upside-down traditionally indicated distress aboard a vessel, usually mutiny!

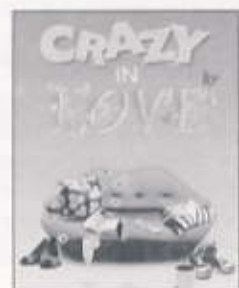

CHANGE TO CUNARD SMOKING POLICY

The safety, comfort and enjoyment of all our guests continues to be our primary concern at Cunard. With this in mind, and as a direct result of the feedback we have received from our guests, we have amended our policy with regard to smoking onboard all Cunard liners. For all voyages departing on or after 22 April 2010, smoking will no longer be permitted in the Casinos on board Cunard liners. Smoking is allowed in Churchill's Cigar Lounge, the port side upper area of the G32 nightclub and designated areas on the open deck, as well as in staterooms and on all private balconies. Smoking will not be permitted in any other inside area of the ship. Smoking of cigars and pipes is only permitted in Churchill's Cigar Lounge. Smoking is also permitted outside on deck 7 aft, under the clock and deck 8 aft under the canopy.

HOTEL MANAGER: JOHN DUFFY, KSG

John Duffy was educated at Liverpool's Jesuit St. Francis Xavier's College and at New York's Cornell University for advanced studies in Hotel Management. In 1965, he joined Cunard, working in a junior capacity on vessels such as QUEEN ELIZABETH, CARINTHIA, CARMANIA, and FRANCONIA. In December 1968, John joined the new QE2 in the Clyde and he remained with her while he gained experience in all aspects of hotel operations at sea. The maiden voyage of Cunard Adventurer spirited him away in 1971 and six months later he was transferred to the Cunard Ambassador for her maiden voyage. By 1976, the CUNARD PRINCESS was being completed and John was seconded to La Spezia, Italy for the final six months of the building. He moved to the top echelons two years later, when in 1978 he was promoted to become Hotel Manager of Cunard Princess. In April 1981, he was again promoted, this time to the position of Hotel Manager aboard QE2 where he remained for over 27 years, taking the ship on her final voyage to Dubai. John is the longest serving four-stripe officer aboard any of the Queen Liners; he was recently awarded the Merchant Navy Medal for distinguished service, and in December 2008 was voted "Seagoing Employee of the Year" at the Seatrade Conference in Venice, the presentation of which took place in London in January 2009. During his time as Hotel Manager, John has looked after many of the most famous names in show business. He has met many of the immediate Royal Family, including Her Majesty The Queen, Prince Philip, and The Queen Mother, all on a couple of occasions, as well as the late Princess Diana, Prince Andrew, and Prince Edward. Other Heads of State and political figures, including Nelson Mandela, are also amongst the household names he has had the pleasure of meeting in his role as Hotel Manager. In the early 1970s John married a local girl, Marie, who was at the time a presenter with BBC Radio Merseyside. They live in a small village just outside Liverpool with their son, Johnny, who is a Barrister. At home, John indulges his hobby of gardening, takes the family Shih Tzu out for walks and watches his soccer team - Everton. So, where does a Hotel Manager go to relax from the pressures of QUEEN MARY 2? Well, with a name like Duffy, only a rented cottage in a quiet corner of Galway or Wicklow (the Republic of Ireland) will do!
