## FROM THE NAVIGATOR

### ⌚ TIME CHANGE

Please be reminded that early this morning the ship's time was **ADVANCED ONE HOUR**. This will be repeated tomorrow and clocks will be **ADVANCED ONE HOUR** early on Saturday morning. Please advance your watches again before retiring this evening Friday, 11 July.

### NAVIGATION INFORMATION

During the early hours of Friday morning we continued on our east bound voyage, passing close to the Flemish Cap of New Found Land as we did. Only 40 miles wide, this area of relatively shallow water feels the effect of the cold Labrador Current flowing from the North and is one of the busiest areas in the Atlantic for commercial fishing. From there we maintained our Great Circle track toward the Bishop Rock and by the afternoon we will have reached a point approximately halfway across the Atlantic. By the evening Queen Mary 2 we will be approximately 600 nautical miles to the north of the island of Flores (the most north-westerly island) in the Azores.

### NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

**POSH** - An acronym deriving from the phrase 'Port Out Starboard Home' which came to stand for the wealthy shipboard travellers who could afford to travel in this way. The letters were said to have been printed on the first-class passengers' tickets, indicating that they had paid extra for cabins on the port side of the ship going out and the starboard side coming home as to avoid the heat and glare of the sun in the Indian Ocean.

## Robert Howie - Hotel Manager

Robert studied in historical Edinburgh, Scotland, graduating with a degree in Hotel Management. His career in catering began by working in various positions in hotels, bars and restaurants throughout Edinburgh. In 1986 Robert headed to Florida for a year to gain some further experience working as a Commis Chef in the Florida Keys. Returning to Scotland he started working for a well known International Hotel chain, as a Restaurant Manager. He remained with this company for three years. His progression throughout this was rapid, taking a position as Deputy Hotel Manager before being promoted again to Training Manager responsible for new openings throughout Scotland and the North East England. In 1990 the desire to travel brought him to Princess Cruises, for what was initially in the "master plan" to be for 18 months. Beginning as a Junior Bar Steward, he rose through the ranks and became Bartender before being appointed to the Princess New Build Team. Over the following eight years Robert brought five Princess ships from the Yard through their Inaugural Season as a Senior Bartender. In 1998 he took a position as Beverage Operations Controller in the Food & Beverage Department of the Corporate Office for the Princess fleet before being promoted again as Manager, Beverage Operations. In late 2000, he returned to sea as Food & Beverage Manager and again became part of the New Build Team. In 2002 he was promoted to F&B Director. His return to sea was short lived and in 2003 Robert was posted to Nagasaki, Japan for a year. It was to be his responsibility to oversee the construction of the galleys, dining rooms and bars on the Diamond and Sapphire Princess. In addition he advised the shipbuilding division of Mitsubishi Heavy Industries on the construction requirements of United States Public Health Vessel Sanitation Programme. In mid-2004 upon completion of the Sapphire Princess, Robert had the rare opportunity to take his project from the drawing board and into service, a career fulfilling goal for him. To have actually designed certain areas, overseeing their manufacture and successfully bringing these elements into service was such a rewarding experience. In October 2004, he joined Cunard Line and Queen Mary 2. He is thrilled to be working on a ship where the traditional elements of cruising are maintained. He is also proud to be now part of such a fantastic tradition and to be working on a truly great Ocean Liner.

When not at sea, he returns to the peace and quiet of his home outside St. Andrews in Scotland, where he is continually renovating his 170 year old cottage. Where it is situated, there are less inhabitants than the total amount of crew on board
