Please be reminded that early this morning the ship's time was SET BACK ONE HOUR. This will be repeated tomorrow and clocks will be SET BACK ONE HOUR early on Friday morning. Please set back your watches again before retiring this evening Thursday, 28 June.

NAVIGATION INFORMATION

Throughout the early hours of the morning we continue along the southwesterly Rhumb Line course. By sunrise we expect to alter onto a Great Circle track leaving the depression off the Irish coast well to the north of us. Our intended track will now take us to a position known as the Tail of the Bank of Newfoundland.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

NAVIGATIONAL LIGHTS

During your first night on board you may have noticed that all the vessels are carrying special coloured lights. These navigation lights are the lights which are laid down under the "International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea" which vessels must display when at sea. They include a white light on the mast (two lights if the vessel is over 50 metres in length and with the second abaft of and higher than the first), red and green sidelights to the port and starboard respectively, and a white stern light; their arcs of visibility are strictly laid down so that it is possible to judge the course of a ship at night by studying the steaming lights which are visible to an observer. Other steaming lights are laid down to indicate various types of vessels at sea, such as fishing craft, sailing boats, tugs with vessels in tow, pilot boats, vessels with restricted ability to manoeuvre, vessels not under command, vessels at anchor, vessels aground, etc.

David Montieth Chef Engineer Officer

David was born and educated at Newcastle upon Tyne, England. He commenced his engineering career with the Vickers Engineering Group at the Armstrong's Elswick works indentured as a technical apprentice. This led to varied work both in production shops and design and drawing offices finally graduating in the fighting vehicles division project management office. Some aspects of working under contract for the British Ministry of Defense was less than inspiring and consequently he decided upon the lifestyle change of working at sea for a year or two!

Accepting employment with P&O line in 1974, he has since worked entirely on passenger vessels. These have been varied and progressed from relatively small older steam powered vessels to large modern cruise ships with inovative electric propulsion systems. His first appointment as Chief Engineer Officer was in 1988 on the Princess Cruises vessel Pacific Princess.

From 1997 he was selected to join Princess Cruises' new building programme for the construction of a series of vessels at Monfalcone in Italy. Other projects have included the take over of two former Renaissance Cruises vessels and the commissioning of the Japanese built vessel Diamond Princess.

In May 2005 he was pleased to be appointed to Queen Mary 2 and join the historic Cunard Line where the product justifies professional commitment and great pride.

David met his wife Julia while aboard the Pacific Princess, the original "Love Boat". She accompanies him onboard when ever possible during his sea appointments. Time ashore is largely spent at the rapidly growing seaside town of Mandurah in Western Australia.



Celebrity Lecturer Salley Vickers

Best selling Novelist, Salley Vickers, rose to prominence when her debut novel, "Miss Garnet's Angel" - about a retired school teacher's surprise visit to Venice - became a publishing phenomenon, a word of mouth best-seller. The novel describes the transformation of retired and retiring Miss Garnet into the socially adept & knowledgeable Julia Garnet. It is also considered a classic introduction to Venice.

Since then, Salley has written three other best-sellers: "Instances of the Number 3," "Mr. Golightly's Holiday" and, most recently, "The Other Side of You." Before becoming a full time writer, Salley worked as a University teacher of literature and as a psychoanalyst. Her novels deal with literature and psychology, as well as spirituality and art. Although the themes are serious, the books are widely read and considered entertaining and accessible. They are great favourites among reading groups and book clubs and Salley was recently voted among one of the top ten book groups favourite authors. She is a mother and a grandmother and lives and works in London and the Welsh Borders. Her name "Salley" means "Willow" in Irish.
